

Auto Accessory Pack

Tips and Tricks

~Take a minute to plan out the spacing of your message and how it will fit on your window before getting started.

~Remove stencil slowly and carefully from top to bottom or side to side.

~Some stencils, particularly the M, W, @ , & are a little trickier to use. When removing them from the backing or the glass, removing in a clockwise motion helps to avoid the stencil sticking on itself.

~Once the backing is removed, pick up top corner of stencil between thumb and index finger and place on glass.

~Align stencils immediately next to each other in each word, leaving a space only between words. This will help you keep straight lines and minimize touch up.

~If you need to reuse a stencil, allow paint on stencil and glass to dry to the touch before removing and re-using, making sure not to get paint on the sticky side of the stencil.

~Don't stack stencils on top of each other

~Waxed paper is a great place to put and store used stencils!

~**For BEST RESULTS: allow paint to FULLY dry before reusing stencil-** when removing stencil from glass-the dryer the paint, the better the result.

~ Clean up smudges or imperfections after stencil is removed and paint is dry!

~**Patience with drying times will vastly improve the quality of your project!!**
Keep temperature and humidity in mind.
